TERMS & CONDITION & REFUND POLICY

Cancellation by Some Odd Pages

If a course is cancelled by Some Odd Pages, you will be notified as quickly as possible and given the opportunity to transfer to another course. Otherwise the full cost of your fees will be refunded to you within three weeks, under normal conditions. Some Odd Pages shall not be liable for any other consequential loss.

Cancellations by you

Cancellations on the part of the student made within 10 working days of the course are non-refundable. Cancellations made before that time will incur a £20 administration charge.

Transferrals

Transferrals from one course to another may be made up to two weeks prior to the course start date.

Substitutions

Participant substitutions may be accepted up to one week prior to the course start date. Substitutions cannot be accepted after the course or session has started.

Non-attendance

Non-attendance of sessions due to illness, or for personal or professional reasons does not provide the right to refunds, extra tuition or transferral to another class. However, in such an event Some Odd Pages shall consider all the circumstances and take such action that we consider fair and reasonable.

Certification

On completion of your course and having attended the minimum number of hours required, Some Odd Pages may provide you with a Certificate of Attendance if requested.

Strikes and Security Alerts

In the event of a public transport strike or closure, or security closures of streets and/or buildings (which occasionally affect the capital and are beyond your control), a class that has commenced may have to be closed early. Sadly, as we will have incurred full costs for such a session, we cannot provide an alternative session, or offer a refund.

Student Conduct

Course participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner and to recognise that other course participants also require support and assistance. If a participant becomes persistently disruptive, we reserve the right to offer a verbal warning. In the unlikely event that this does not resolve the situation, the participant may be asked to leave the course.

Overseas participants

If you are arriving for a course or session from outside the UK, it is essential that you advise us of your full UK address, telephone, email and other contact details two weeks prior to your course commencing in case we need to advise you of any changes. Some Odd Pages does not make refunds for accommodation or travel costs associated with courses, for any reason whatsoever.

Student Visa

Short course students are not eligible to apply for a student visa. Students who need a visa to enter the UK must contact the British Embassy in their own country and make prior arrangements before booking a short course.

English

Applicants for courses and sessions whose first language is not English should note that they are required to be moderately proficient in written and spoken English and be able to participate in group discussions and presentations in English. Participants on short courses should have a good working knowledge of English.
